ORDER APPROVING THIRD AND FINAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE HUNTSMAN AND BASF SETTLEMENT FUNDS

AND NOW, this 17th day of October, 2016, upon consideration of Class Plaintiffs' Motion For Leave to Make the Third and Final Distribution of the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds, Dkt. No. 3278 ("Final Distribution Motion"); the Declaration of Lorna Lightfoot-Ware in Support of Class Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Make the Third and Final Distribution of the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds (Dkt. No. 3278-1); any timely objections to the Final Distribution Motion that were filed with the Court; any reply from the Plaintiffs in support of their motion; and the entire record in this matter, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- The Court authorizes the third and final distribution of the Huntsman and BASF
 Settlement Funds as requested in the Final Distribution Motion.
- 2. The Court appoints The Garden City Group as Settlement Administrator to conclude the distribution of the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds.
- 3. \$31,747.00 shall be reserved in the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds for the fees and expenses associated with completing the distribution of the Huntsman and BASF

Settlement Funds, and Class Counsel is authorized to instruct the Escrow Agent to pay such fees

and expenses from the amounts reserved in the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds.

4. Class Counsel shall be reimbursed \$5,150.30 from the Huntsman and BASF

Settlement Funds for payment of invoices submitted by Rust Consulting Services, LLC for its

settlement administration work in 2016.

5. The monies in the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds that exceed the amounts

reserved for settlement administration and reimbursement of Class Counsel (as set forth in

paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Order) shall be transferred to a Distribution Account and distributed pro

rata to all Authorized Claimants whose distribution payment would be \$10.00 or more.

6. In making this third and final distribution, the Settlement Administrator shall use

the same Recognized Loss Amounts and follow the same methodology and procedures that were

ordered by the Court for the second distribution of the Huntsman and BASF Settlement Funds.
