

set forth in Section 1 of the Plan.

b. In processing and reviewing the claims, as set forth in Section 2 of the Plan, the Claims Administrator shall use reasonable efforts within a reasonable time to contact and provide additional notice to class members who have not submitted a claim by the claims deadline.

c. In determining whether to accept or reject a late claim, as set forth in Section 2 of the Plan, Class Counsel shall consider whether acceptance of the claim would significantly delay the distribution of the settlement fund or related proceedings.

3. The Court approves the Proof of Claim Form in the form attached as Appendix A to the Plan, as amended to comply with this Order, and authorizes its distribution to the members of the Class in accordance with the Plan.

4. Class Counsel are authorized to carry out all steps necessary to effectuate the Plan.

5. In accordance with the Plan, Class Counsel shall notify the Court when they are prepared to file a recommended Schedule of Distribution, at which time Class Counsel shall request a date for the Distribution Hearing.

6. Upon receiving a Distribution Hearing date, Class Counsel shall file the recommended Schedule of Distribution. At least twenty-one (21) days before the Distribution Hearing date, Class Counsel shall notify in writing any claimant whose claim was rejected or modified of the Distribution Hearing date and the procedure for filing objections to their individual claim determination. Any such objections to individual claim determinations must be filed with the Court and served upon Class Counsel postmarked no later than ten (10) days before the Distribution Hearing date, and any response thereto must be filed with the Court no later than five (5) days before the Distribution Hearing date.
